TENDER FEE:- Tender Fee is COMPULSORY.No exemption from payment of tender fees and no price preference to the small, cottage & tiny industrial units registered under small scale industries of Gujarat state and holding subsequent registration with CSPO/NSIC/DGS&D registration certificates for the item under tender. Tender Fee will be accepted by D.D. in favour of Uttar Gujarat Vij Company Ltd., payable at Visnagar. Cheque is not accepted & Tenders submitted without tender fee will not be accepted.

EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:- EMD at 1 % of the estimated cost is to be paid by D.D. in favour of Uttar Gujarat Vij Company Ltd. payable at Visnagar Tenders without EMD are liable for rejection.

The exemption in payment of EMD shall be given to the small, cottage & Tiny Industrial Units registered under small scale industries of Gujarat State and holding subsequent registration with CSPO/NSIC/DGS&D registration Certificates for the item under tender. Otherwise tender / offer will be ignored. The Xerox copy submitted for SSI / NSIC must be duly notarized on notarial stamp (ticket) & signature. Registration certificates submitted other than indented material will not be accepted for waiver of EMD / SD and without payment of EMD, tender will be rejected out rightly without intimation to the party. No correspondence will be entertained further in the matter.

Technical Bid:- Bidder has to submit tender in one Envelop and in this two different covers should be put. One cover mentioning **Technical bid** on it & another cover mentioning **Commercial Bid** on it. If we receive envelop that do not have two separate sealed covers than those bids are liable to be rejected. Technical bid should be submitted with documents as under, failing which tender is liable for rejection.

The technical bid shall comprise of all the technical details of the stores /materials offered in accordance with the Corporation guaranteed technical particulars and conditions, etc. The Technical Bid shall be opened on Due Date as mentioned in tender Notice (If Possible), in the presence of those tenderers who wish to be present. If the Authorized Representative is likely to be present then he must submit the authorization letter of the representing company at the time of opening of Bids and this is compulsory Only One authorized Representative shall be allowed. 1. Earnest Money Deposit :-

- (b) Tender without earnest money, deposit is not liable to be considered.

2. Validity of Tenders :-

All tenders shall be opened for acceptance by the company for a period of 90 days from the date of opening the tenders and may be further extend to 30 days, if required and the tenderer shall be bound to execute the supply on such acceptance

3. Acceptance of Tenders :-

The Company does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender either will any reason be assigned for the rejection; it is also not binding on the company to disclose any analysis report on the tender.

4. Security Deposit :-

The lowest tenderer whose tender is accepted shall have to pay 5 % Security Deposit of the order value, in cash within 10 days from the receipt of the acceptance order. In case supplier fails, his earnest money will be forfeited and order cancelled without issuing any notice.

5. Contract documents :-

The lowest tenderer whose tender is accepted will have to execute a stamped agreement in standard form of the company and will have to sign the booklet at his own cost. In case of partnership firms necessary partnership document will have to be produced for verification on authority to sign the bills measurements enter and into contract as well correspondence with the company. Wherever required necessary power of attorney will have to be produced.

14. Addressing Tenders :-

Tenders must be submitted in envelopes which must be properly sealed by the tenderer with their office seal and must be super scribed with following.

(a) Tender No. (b) Returnable date and time of the tender.

It is responsibility of the tenderer to see that the tenders received in company's office or tender box within the stipulated time and date.

15. The Company's General conditions of contract will apply to all the suppliers and he is deemed to be fully aware company's General conditions of contract for the works in respect of security deposit terms of payments penalty for the delivery of supplier etc. and any ignorance of these conditions will not exempt the supplier from the Company's office as per prevailing price only.

16. Deviation of specification :-

Preference will be given to tendering firms whose rates according to tender specifications.

17. Terms of payments:-

Bill shall be submitted by the supplier after completion of entire ordered supply.

18. Recording of measurements in the presence of supplier :-

(a) In case of supply carried out satisfactorily by the supplier, the supplier by prior intimation from the company's officers shall have to witness the recording of measurements on the appointment date within one month of completion of supply either the conditions as specification vide condition No. 5 read with condition No.4(b) or tender and supply for works.

(b) Booklet shall apply and the recording of measurements shall be done within one month of completions of supply after replacement of defect by the company at the contractor's cost as the case may be and any further delay in the recording of measurement and finalization of the bill due to the fault of the supplier shall be subject to the conditions as laid down in clause (a)

19. Extension of time limit :-

The time limit for supplying materials is within 30 days from the date of issuing the orders. Extension of time limit if for any reasons, the suppliers is not in a position to supply within the stipulated period, he should put his application to the Engineer In charge before one month of expiry of the stipulated time limit or completion of supply for the extension of time limit giving valid reasons for the required extension.

20. GST (Service Tax)

(A) The GST/Service at the prevailing rate should be paid as per the rules.

Contractor shall have to pay whatever applicable taxes prevailing at the time of placement of order execution of work /Bill payment etc.

- 1) Sealed Tenders are invited for the work Providing and fixing of maintenance free electrode earthing as per specification under Kheralu & Vadnagar sub division of Visnagar Division for DDUGJY/IPDS scheme. from the contractors/firms who have executed works of similar nature and magnitude successfully and who are registered under appropriate class.
- 2) Tender documents are in two bids system i.e. "Technical Bid" and "Price Bid".
 - 2.1 Technical bid is to be submitted in a separate sealed envelope and super scribing the envelope as "Technical Bid". Technical bid should be submitted with documents as under, failing which tender is liable for rejection.
 - (a) Solvency certificate issued from any Nationalized Bank amounting to 20 % equivalent of estimated cost (as per UGVCL Rules)
 - (b) Separate EPF code No. allotted by RPFC & Last Six month of current year EPF Challan paid copy is required.
 - (c) Latest income tax clearance certificate.
 - (d) Experience certificate as per requirement for same work by authorized officer of Distribution Company.
 - (e) Group Insurance copy of the insurance policy of the insured labourer's under W.C. Act.
 - (f) Details of equipments available with the tendered.

(g) Electrical contractor.

(h) Tools & tackle Certificate.

Price of bidders, who are not qualified technically as per requirement of technical bid shall not be opened.

- 27) If the Bidder/Contractor would stand lowest while opening of the tender,He will be intimated by the competent authority with separate letter & will have to provide their skilled Labours gang within week time & He would have to report in written through respective SDO. Otherwise Second lowest bidder will be given chance at the rate of lowest
- 28) The contractor should have to keep permanently skilled labours gang in respective Sub-Division for each annual order. If Concern SDO will report that Erection Work is delayed due to non availability of skilled labour, penalty will be deducted a per rules.
- 29) All the works shall be carried out as per specifications attached with the tender and relevant Indian Standard issued by Bureau Indian Standards. All materials procured should be confirming to relevant Indian Standard issued by Bureau of Indian Standard.
- 30) Tenders, which do not fulfill all or any of the conditions of the tender of incomplete in any respect, are liable to rejection.

Specification for Eco friendly Maintenance Free Earthing

Maintenance free earthing system comprising of 50 X6 mm dia 3 mtr long Earth electrode of low Carbon steel electrode with 250 microns copper coating with a bag of (23 kg) of Carbon based environment friendly special backfill compound with a suitable GI clamp.

Electrode

- The electrode shall be a solid steel rod made of high tensile low carbon steel and coated with molecularly bonded copper on the outside as per UL 467.
- The thickness of the copper coating shall be atleast 250 microns.
- The electrode diameter shall be 50 x6 mm.
- The earth electrode shall carry UL marking and manufacturer's name.
- The length of the electrode shall be 3 mtrs.

Chemical Compound (Backfill material)

Highly conductive and Eco friendly backfill material: The backfill material shall be highly conductive. The backfill Material shall be carbon based and of low resistance, non corrosive, highly conductive carbon based powdered material that improves grounding effectiveness, especially in areas of high soil resistivity such as rocky and sandy areas. This material shall be suitable to be installed in either slurry or dry form.

The material shall attain the hardening characteristics of cement when mixed with water or exposed to moisture while retaining its' properties. The backfill material shall confirm to the following specifications:

- a. Shall be highly electrically conductive and non-soluble.
- b. Shall not leak into ground.
- c. Shall have a resistivity of less than 0.1 ohm meter as per clause 14.5 (d) of IEEE 80
- d. Shall be compatible with all copper grounding systems
- e. Shall contain a corrosion inhibitor to mitigate corrosion of copper
- f. Shall not contain hazardous chemicals
- g. Shall not be affected by drought and shall be stable between -10° to + 50° C temperature.
- h. Shall not depend on presence of moisture for conductivity but shall be electronically conductive like metals.
- i. Shall be suitable for any kind of soil
- j. The compound should have been tested in a reputed laboratory for not containing any hazardous chemicals as per EPA Chapter 7.
- k. The compound shall be carbon based conductive concrete and shall not contain bentonite in any form.

The bottom 300mm of the bore hole shall be filled with good, preferably black cotton soil. The balance length of the bore hole shall be filled entirely with the backfill compound in pure form without mixing with soil. The compound shall bond tightly with the electrode and become a solid mass.
